

To give those seeking a certificate of proficiency as a Ship Security Officer (SSO) the essential education and training meeting the Knowledge, Understanding and Proficiency (KUP) requirements.

Set out in accordance with STCW table A VI/5, which supports Chapter X1-2 of SOLAS 1974 as amended and the ISPS Code's part A/12.2 and B/13.2, the IMO model course 3.19.

Upon completion a certificate of proficiency will be issued.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: Persons attending the course must have:

Approved seagoing service of not less than 12 months or

At the discretion of the Ministry appropriate sea service (minimum 3 months) and knowledge of ship operations to enable them to achieve the objectives of the training.

COURSE DURATION: Three days.

OBJECTIVES: Those who successfully complete this course will have the competence to:

Maintain and supervise the implementation of a ship facility security plan;

Assess security risk, threat and vulnerability;

Undertake regular inspections of the ship to ensure that appropriate security measures are implemented and maintained;

Ensure that security equipment and systems are properly operated, tested and calibrated:

Encourage security awareness and vigilance.
